### Food for Thought!

In today's Gospel we hear the most famous sermon Jesus ever preached: the Beatitudes. The meaning is still as powerful for us today, more than 2,000 years later. Yet many of us simply pass over it because we don't see how it applies to our life. How can anyone possibly find happiness in poverty, hunger, mourning, and persecution? Yet, poverty of spirit can find joy in knowing that God is the greatest treasure possible. Hunger of the spirit seeks nourishment and strength in God's word: to be a peacemaker and seek forgiveness and repentance leads to a joyful freedom from the burden of guilt.

The Beatitudes which Jesus offers us are a sign of contradiction to the world's understanding of happiness and joy! The Beatitudes are both an encouragement and a challenge for Christians, because they don't speak of what might be, rather they say to us that this is meant to be our experience now, and if it's not then we need to ask ourselves why – what's stopping us from knowing the joy that Jesus talks about.

What's dragging us down? May our lives here on earth shine with God's love like all the Saints, so that we can be filled with joy when we see the Lord face to face. Praise Him!!

We pray that people who suffer from depression or burn-out will find support and a light that opens them up to life.

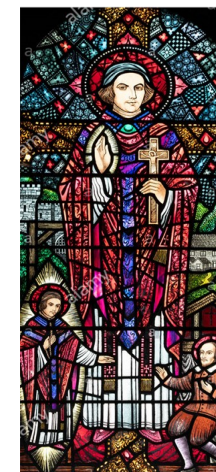
