CHURCH RE-OPENING

The priests of the deanery have consulted together and following guidance from the archdiocese we are looking to cautiously reopen our churches the **weekend of Saturday, 27th and Sunday, 28th March**, which is **Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week**. This is dependent upon how the rates of infection are in the local area and the safeguarding of all people who may attend church. The previous model of booking places with the parish office is being continued and bookings will be taken **no earlier than Tuesday 23rd March**. Face masks will continue to be required to be worn unless medically exempt, and I point out recent changes in government guidelines that state that **visors do not offer any protection unless worn with a face mask so face masks are what is stated to be worn in places of worship**.

In the current lockdown, from 8th March

- Baptisms are still not permitted except in danger of death.
- Weddings may take place with 6 attendees.
- Funerals which take place in church may only be attended by up to 30 people maximum.

No earlier than 12th April

- Funerals no change
- Weddings with up to 12 attendees
- Single household baptisms with proxy Godparents

No earlier than 17th May

- Funerals no change
- Weddings with up to 30 attendees
- Baptisms with up to 30 attendees

No earlier than 21st June

- Funeral and wedding restrictions lifted
- First Communion may take place in traditional way but likely to be limited by ongoing social distancing requirements.

With regard to singing in church, no advice has yet been given about a change in regulations already made.

The Sunday **9.30am** Mass will be broadcast and for those who can access it the video will remain to be watched anytime afterwards if you miss it live. Where possible daily Masses will be broadcast and other prayer services which can also be watched and participated in at any time later.

Mass on the Phone: For those without internet, who are unable to watch online Mass, Sunday Mass is available by telephone from Middlesbrough Cathedral, charged as a local call or free if in your included minutes. **Phone 01642 130120** to be connected to the Mass for that week. You can listen at any time of day or night. **If you are aware of anyone who may benefit from this service, please let them know.**

Food Collection: Thank you for continued donations for the food bank operating in St Gabriel's school for the families in need there. Non-perishable food such as tinned or dried food may be left at church or dropped off at Holy Family Presbytery. Any surplus food will be sent to other food banks locally.

Easter Cards to the Holy Land: This is the time of year when we normally send Easter Cards to the Holy Land, and we want to send that simple greeting and message of hope to our fellow Christians again this year. However, due to the current restrictions, we are having to do things differently this year perhaps sending e-greetings where possible.
