New Bishop Appointed

Pope Francis has appointed Canon Thomas Neylon of the Archdiocese of Liverpool to be Bishop of Plestia and Auxiliary Bishop of Liverpool. Bishop-elect Tom was born and grew up in Warrington. Ordained by Pope St John Paul II in 1982 he has served in pastoral ministry in Wigan, Skelmersdale, St Helens and Widnes. Archbishop Malcolm will ordain him Bishop on Friday, 3 September, the Feast of Pope St Gregory the Great, in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King.
