### CHURCH IS OPEN

Guidance has been received from the archdiocese allowing a lessening of restrictions. However, after consultation with stewards and others it has been decided that we will cautiously remain as we are for the summer. This is because of very high transmission rates in our local area. Singing is now allowed and as such we will look to reintroduce this over coming weeks depending upon the availability of parish musicians.

The practice of booking places with the parish office is being continued and bookings will be taken each week from **Tuesday**. Face masks will continue to be required to be worn unless medically exempt, and I point out recent changes in government guidelines that state that **visors do not offer any protection unless worn with a face mask so face masks are what is stated to be worn in places of worship.** *Note: No parish Masses/services will be livestreamed whilst Fr Paul is on holiday.*

**Church Hall Development** - With great joy we hand over the land at Holy Family to the contractors who will be developing a new Parish Hall and car parking until Easter 2022. This will cause some disruption to both parish and school as parking will be reduced and at times there will be no access at all as the project goes forward. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we will no doubt enjoy and benefit greatly from new facilities and a proper car park.

**New Bishop Appointed** - Pope Francis has appointed Canon Thomas Neylon of the Archdiocese of Liverpool to be Bishop of Plestia and Auxiliary Bishop of Liverpool. Bishop-elect Tom was born and grew up in Warrington. Ordained by Pope St John Paul II in 1982 he has served in pastoral ministry in Wigan, Skelmersdale, St Helens and Widnes. Archbishop Malcolm will ordain him Bishop on Friday, 3 September, the Feast of Pope St Gregory the Great, in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King.
