READINGS FOR THE WEEKEND.

First Reading- Isaiah 35:1-6,10

God is the hope of his people who are crushed with misfortune.

Second Reading James 5:7-10

Gospel Reading – Matthew 11:2-11

GOSPEL REFLECTION.

Isaiah uses the image of the desert, made fertile by rain, to portray the confident hope that God would restore his people, who have been crushed by such misfortune. All their misfortunes will be relieved when God sends salvation to his people. In the Second Reading, St. James talks about the Second Coming and shares his hope that people will be patient, just as farmers have to be patient in waiting for the harvest. According to James, if the people remain faithful and hopeful, then peace and salvation shall reign for them.

John the Baptist's image of the Messiah was that of a stern judge who would execute his fiery judgment. But Jesus did not fit this image. Hence, John seems to doubt that Jesus could be the Messiah at first. However, Jesus dispels John's doubts by showing that he was doing precisely the kind of king that the Messiah was sent to do – heal the sick, raise the dead, help the poor and reveal the Kingdom of God to all people. Like John the Baptist, amongst the doubts and fears we sometimes have to face, let us open our hearts to the love and mercy of God, given to us through the life of Jesus himself.
