### **GOSPEL REFLECTION.**

The story of Zacchaeus in today's Gospel should challenge all of us. It makes us think of our sense of belonging-belonging to our nation, perhaps, our families, friendship groups, our Parish. Do we define who we belong to - and therefore who belongs to us – in terms of excluding others? Are we welcoming, as Zacchaeus welcomed Jesus into his home and as Jesus welcomed Zacchaeus into his group of followers? We can easily fall into the trap of welcoming people who we happen to like, or have a certain bond with, or people we don't feel threatened by. But what about those we don't like? How do we reach out to them? If Jesus and Zacchaeus were not welcoming people, then today's Gospel would be very different indeed.

And like Zacchaeus, who after meeting Jesus promised to give half his money to the poor, how open are we to being transformed? Like Zacchaeus, can we acknowledge our own vulnerability, mistakes and imperfections? Are we willing to "climb a tree" to go out of our comfort zone to seek out opportunities to be renewed by God's love? The Gospel today reminds us that there is always a way back with God and that, as Jesus celebrated a meal in Zacchaeus' house; God celebrates when we turn back to him.
