GOSPEL REFLECTION.

In today's First Reading, Isaiah foretells that, even though the family tree of Jesus, King David's father, has been reduced to a mere stump, nevertheless, from that stump a new shoot will spring – a true King filled with the Spirit and blessed with all the virtues of his ancestors. The new King, the Messiah, will be a champion of the poor and will restore peace.

In the Gospel, Matthew introduces John the Baptist as the herald, for told by the prophet Isaiah, of the long-awaited Messiah, and the one who prepared the people to receive him and accept him into their hearts. Matthew presents Jesus as the one who would fulfil the Old Testament promises. Paul, in the Second Reading to the Romans, also sees Jesus in this way, as the fulfilment of God's promises, and promises peace and everlasting life to those ho believe in him.
