#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION.**

In the Gospel this weekend we hear of the wonderful encounter that Jesus had with the woman from Samaria. Jesus asked her for water, then later gave her the water of life, the water of hope, faith and love. She was very much an outcast, yet Jesus approached her and made her feel loved and special by asking her to help him, to give him water. St.Paul tells us that the three main virtues are faith, hope and love, with the greatest being love. It is very clear that without faith there can be no hope, and without these two there can be no lasting love. We are challenged by God to have hope not only in God's saving grace but in our own capacity to lead people closer to God, even when we feel we are not up to the task.

Both Moses, in the First Reading, and the Samaritan woman, in today's Gospel, became leaders when they learned that God's power can and does overcome our weaknesses. In God's eyes, whatever our weaknesses are, we are enough. When we open ourselves up to live in intimate relationship with Jesus, nothing can separate us from God's love. On our own we are powerless. But with God, all things area possible, and even our poor efforts can make a difference to how the world is and will be. So, as we continue our journey through Lent, let us pray that we may allow God's grace to flow through us so that, in our own little way, we may make a difference to the world in which we live.
