GOSPEL REFLECTION.

Jesus speaks from the depths of his heart. He tells us of the Father's love for him and his love for his Father, who is the heart and centre of his life. The Father's love continues to be with him right to the end, even to the Cross, to the point of giving his all, his life.

All our life we seek to know him, through his words and parables, and through the world which he has entrusted to us. At no stage can we ever say that we fully understand God. Saint Augustine wrote: "Understanding is the reward of faith. Therefore, do not seek to understand in order to believe, but believe that you may understand". Our human mission is to seek God through the world around us, and to remain a God-seeker until the day when he reveals himself to us when we meet him face to face.
