* * * * * * * Advent

Advent starts on the fourth Sunday before Christmas Day. Advent comes from the Latin adventus, meaning 'arrival' or 'coming'. It's a key time in which we prepare ourselves to celebrate the Lord coming into the world as the incarnate God of love. The liturgical vestments priests wear during the season are purple, matching the candles lit on each Sunday of Advent. Purple is a colour typically associated with penance. The exception is the third Sunday - Gaudete Sunday - when priests wear pink (or rose) vestments - the colour of rejoicing.

"Advent has a two-fold character: for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered; and likewise when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period for devout and expectant delight." Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year
