Ash Wednesday: Although not a Holy Day of Obligation, many will no doubt wish to come to Mass to mark the beginning of the season of Lent. Mass times are 12noon at St Ambrose and 7pm at Holy Family. Services of Ashes will take place in the schools throughout the day.

Confirmations 2024: Any young person who is in year 8 or above, has made their First Holy Communion and would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation can register for Sacramental preparation at www.liverpoolcalled.co.uk. The website for registration opened on the 15th January and closes on the 15th March. While the registration period is open, Animate will visit schools in the diocese to promote the Sacrament. At the same time, schools will teach about the Sacrament of Confirmation in RE classes.
